1. APPLY FOR ADMISSION

- Visit tinyurl.com/Mission-Apply to create a student account and to apply. Within 24 hours, you'll receive a Student ID Number (e.g., G01234567).
 - Keep an eye out for emails from CCCApply and West Valley-Mission Community College District (WVMCCD) regarding your account status and instructions.
 - F-1 international students should apply at iis.missioncollege.edu.
 - Noncredit students should apply at missioncollege.edu/depts/noncredit
 - Dual enrollment students must receive approval from their parents/guardians and a counselor. More information is available at hs.missioncollege.edu

2. ACCESS THE MY MISSION PORTAL

Utilize your WVMCCD email to create an account and password to access resources in the My Mission Portal and complete the remaining steps.

A. Complete Orientation

B. Meet with a Counselor

Schedule an appointment or drop-in with a counselor.

C. Register and Pay for Classes

Sign up and pay for classes using your Student ID Number (e.g., G01234567).

- Students interested in enrolling in Math or English courses must first acknowledge placements.
- Students enrolling in ESL courses must complete the ESL placement process, which is accessible at assessment.missioncollege.edu.

D. Financial Aid

Students in our district must submit a FAFSA/CADAA to activate their Enrollment Fee Grant. Students from outside the district are encouraged to submit their FAFSA/CADAA to determine eligibility for additional aid.
