WHAT IS AN AS-T?

COLLEGE SANTA CLARA

The Associate in Science for Transfer (AS-T) is intended for students who plan to transfer and complete a bachelor's degree in a similar major at a CSU campus. Students completing these transfer degrees:

- will earn an Associate's Degree from Mission College;
- are guaranteed admission to a campus in the CSU system;
- will be prepared to start upper division coursework at the CSU;
- and will not have to complete more than 60 units after transfer.

To earn this AS-T, students must meet the following requirements:

- Completion 60 CSU-transferable semester units with an overall grade point average of at least 2.0;
- Completion of a minimum of 24 semester units in the major with a grade of "C" (or "P") or better; and
- Certified completion of either the <u>California State University General Education</u>
 <u>Breadth pattern (CSU GE-B)</u> or the <u>Intersegmental General Education Transfer</u>
 <u>Curriculum (IGETC)</u>.

Notes:

- 1. While a minimum of 2.0 is required for admission, some majors may require a higher GPA. Please consult with a counselor for more information.
- 2. Completing courses prior to transfer that satisfy the U.S. History, Constitution and American Ideals requirement as part to the CSU GE-B or IGETC is highly recommended.
- 3. MC Graduation requirements, LIB 010 and READ 054, are NOT required for this degree.
- 4. Submit the <u>AA-T/AA-S Application for the Degree</u> to the Admissions and Records Office.
