As both of you know, the Academic Senate is scheduled to review the program review process this fall. The Senate will be revisiting the model that was created in 2002-03 but not implemented when we elected to go with the current approach in order to get all programs and services on a level playing field. We also used the current process in order to address educational planning and SLOs. The next phase of program review will hopefully incorporate the best aspects of the two approaches and perhaps consider other alternatives, the goal being a do-able process that ensures on-going assessment and evaluation. The other goal is to come up with a process that directly links program review and resource allocation. The EFMP process laid the foundation for that linkage, but it is only the foundation. I am asking that in the course of its review, the Senate work collaboratively with CBAC to create a process that results in an integrated planning process that links program review and resource allocation.
