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Liberal Arts: Social and Behavioral Sciences: Associate in Arts (AA)

The Associate in Arts in Liberal Arts with an emphasis in Social and Behavioral Sciences provides students an opportunity to develop a broad perspective on concepts, theories and methodologies of the disciplines typically found in the variety of disciplines that comprise the study in the social and behavioral sciences. Students study about themselves and others as a member of a larger society in order to gain a basic knowledge of the cultural and social organizations in which they exist as well as the behavioral and social organizations of other human societies.

Program Learning Outcomes:

- Evaluate human behavior in relation to human, social, political, and economic institutions.
- Evaluate and critique past, present, and future issues from a historical, cultural, psychological, and social perspective.

Career/Transfer Opportunities:

The program is intended for students who are considering transfer, but have not decided on a major; students who are required to complete a degree for job promotion; or students who may wish to further their education and are considering a major that is interdisciplinary in focus.

To earn this degree, students must meet the following requirements:

1. Completion of 60 degree applicable units with an overall GPA of 2.0.
2. Completion of a minimum of 18 semester units in the major with a grade of C (or P) or better.
3. Completion of the AA/AS Graduation Requirements, CSU GE-B or IGETC.

Core Requirements (18 units):

Complete a minimum of eighteen units from the following

All courses approved for California State University General Education Certification and Certificate of Achievement Requirements (CSU GE-B) Area D.

Must include courses from at least two different disciplines.

Completion of General Education Requirements and electives as needed to reach 60 units.
