Preparation for Academic Success in ESL: Certificate of Competency (CC) (Noncredit)

The Low-Intermediate English as a Second Language Program equips students with listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills for success in the intermediate level credit ESL program.

Program Learning Outcomes:

- Demonstrate the English language skills, study skills, college success skills, and the computer skills needed to access 21st century learning materials and to succeed in an academic ESL program at the intermediate level.

Career/Transfer Opportunities:

The goal of the Preparation for Academic Success in ESL program is to offer students a variety of learning opportunities to gain proficiency in the English language, and achieve academic, career, and/or personal goals. Students earn this certificate by successfully completing a sequence of two courses. The program offers two integrated skills core courses, one at the beginning level and one at the high-beginning level. The courses are sequenced to focus on increasing proficiency in the academic reading, writing, speaking, listening, critical thinking, study skills, and computer skills needed to be successful in a college setting. This program provides students with a means to prepare for more academic ESL coursework at the intermediate level.
