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Three-Dimensional Arts: Certificate of Achievement (CA)

The Certificate of Achievement in Three-Dimensional Arts is designed to direct students who seek to concentrate in the arts with a focus on three-dimensional applications, which include, design, sculpture, ceramics, metalsmithing, and metal sculpture casting.

Program Learning Outcomes:

- Create and critique works of three-dimensional art in a supportive environment using traditional and new art media according to established principles of art and design. Communicate orally and in writing about art and design related topics.
- Develop their vision to devise innovative solutions to creative and technical problems.
- Present to the instructor a portfolio of three-dimensional artwork which will be evaluated according to the criteria of technical mastery, creativity, solving problems with original solutions, and meeting the stated goals of the assignment.
- Analyze, compare and contrast, and trace the development of art forms from different parts of the world, from ancient to modern times.

Career/Transfer Opportunities:

Career opportunities include the following: education/teaching, furniture designer, jewelry design, museum/gallery professional, and arts administrator.
