



For Faculty: Assigning *O'Reilly Safari Books & Tutorials* to Students

O'Reilly Safari Books Online includes tech and business ebooks from more than 250 publishers along with videos, case studies, exclusive O'Reilly-produced content from world-renowned innovators and corporate leaders, expert-curated learning paths and self-assessments.

Faculty may assign students books, book chapters, and tutorials to read online or via the mobile app (Safari Queue). It is recommended that you provide the exact title/author of the item and the URL so students may find it via the link or search for the item if they are using the App. This database is different than most at Mission College as it requires a College email address to access it. You may need to provide your students with a link to help them find their College email. Instructions are on the *O'Reilly Safari Books Online* page (<http://libguides.missioncollege.edu/oreilly-safari>) which is linked on the Library's Research Databases page.

Below is an example of text you may want to include in your syllabus or send to students if you are using a textbook from this database.

Required Textbook

This class uses a digital textbook that is free of charge to students. It is available through the Mission College Library database, *O'Reilly Safari Books Online*.

Textbook information: Title, author, year published

Steps to access the textbook in *O'Reilly Safari Books Online*:

Note: You need your West Valley-Mission College email address to access this book. If you do not know your College email, go to the *O'Reilly Safari Books Online* page and follow the directions to find it: <http://libguides.missioncollege.edu/oreilly-safari>.

1. Click on the following link to access the class textbook: [Put link to book here]
2. Enter your College email to register for an account or click "Already a user?" to sign in if you already have an *O'Reilly Safari* account.
3. Follow the directions to set up an account or login. If you are a new user, you will have access immediately, but you will need to validate your account via your College email later to continue to use it. If you do not validate it within two days, you will lose all of the information in your Playlist.
4. Once you are logged in, add the book to your Playlist. Your Playlist is like a folder, it is a place to save books and material you want to access later. Once a book is in your Playlist you will be able to highlight passages and add notes. To add a highlight or note, select a word or section of text and a pop up menu will appear.
5. Next time you log into *O'Reilly Safari Books Online* you can access your Playlist by clicking on the Playlist icon from the left menu.
