RESOLUTION OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENT GOVERNMENT

MISSION COMMUNITY COLLEGE

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A REMOTE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION POLICY

WHEREAS, during the novel coronavirus pandemic, the Associated Student Government used a virtual meeting tool that allowed the district to continue holding meetings and provided a way for the public to participate in meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Associated Student Government recognizes that public participation is a critical component of the civic process and values the input it receives from members of the public during meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Associated Student Government wishes to make it easier for the public to comment during meetings by providing the public with a way to participate remotely in most public meetings of the Associated Student Government, in addition to attending meetings in person or submitting written comments in advance of the meeting; and

WHEREAS, AB361 requires Brown Act compliant bodies wishing to conduct virtual meetings review public health conditions every 30 days, adopt a resolution confirming their continued determination that the Governor's emergency proclamation remains in effect, and that social distancing is still recommended or that there is a continuing public health risk associated with in-person meetings,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Associated Student Government hereby establishes compliance with AB 361 and Governor Newsom's executive order allowing our body to continue meeting remotely during proclaimed states of emergency.
